Eligibility

Students attending: Chamberlain University

Credit hours completed: minimum of 24 credits

GPA: 2.7 or higher

One scholarship will be awarded to an eligible student currently enrolled at Chamberlain University. This scholarship was established in memory of Kathleen Modene, a former Chamberlain University faculty member. She was part of the team that led the transition of Deaconess College of Nursing to Chamberlain College of Nursing. She facilitated the growth of Chamberlain from the original St. Louis campus to more than 20 campuses located nationwide. She was also responsible for Chamberlain nursing programs gaining and maintaining national accreditation status. Her last position was Director, Institutional and Programmatic Accreditation. This scholarship was established by family, friends and her Chamberlain colleagues to continue her legacy.

Requirements

Application completely filled out

Explain how you will demonstrate these attributes throughout the remainder of your training and career (re-read your checking for grammatical and spelling errors).

Letter of Recommendation from a faculty member or nursing professional. Be sure to follow up on your request to remind them of their deadline to submit.
