Eligibility

Students attending: Ross University School of Veterinary Medicine

Academic Status: Entering into their clinical year

Details

A scholarship valued up to \$5,000 that was created by the Zareski Family Trust, in memory of a RUSVM 2002 graduate, Dr. Michael Zareski. Eligible students attending Ross University School of Veterinary medicine that are in or will be entering into their clinical year when applying for the scholarship.

About Dr. Mike

A 2002 graduate of Ross University School of Veterinary Medicine, Dr. Zareski was a member of the RUSVM Alumni Action Council who dedicated his life to helping others. In addition to his practice, Western Veterinary Group in Palos Verdes, CA, Dr. Zareski founded the 4EverFoundation, a nonprofit organization that helps cats and kittens find adoptive homes. Dr. Zareski lost his life in a tragic accident in December of 2017. This scholarship, established by the Zareski Family Trust, will continue his legacy by providing a \$5,000 scholarship to a student who embodies Dr. Zareski's spirit of helping others.

Requirements

Applications completely filled out

Essay question: *Please describe why the clinical portion of your veterinary medicine education is important to the overall education of a veterinarian.* (re-read your essay checking for grammatical and spelling errors)

Letter of Recommendation from a faculty member or nursing professional. Be sure to follow up on your request to remind them of their deadline to submit.
