Eligibility

Students attending: American University of the Caribbean School of Medicine

Credit hours completed: minimum of 24 credits

GPA: 3.0 or higher

Details

One scholarship, valued at \$2,200, will be awarded to an eligible student currently enrolled at American University of the Caribbean School of Medicine. This award is directed to the institution and is to be applied to tuition expenses only.

Requirements

- I. Applications completely filled out
- II. Essay question: Describe your experience in providing community service in a developing country, disadvantaged community, or equivalent, and how it affected your outlook on providing medical care to those less fortunate. (re-read your essay checking for grammatical and spelling errors)
- III. Letter of Recommendation from a faculty member or nursing professional. Be sure to follow up on your request to remind them of their deadline to submit.
