About Dr. Fox

After graduating from Texas A&M in 2009, Lanse pursued his lifelong dream of becoming a veterinarian when he attended Ross University's School of Veterinary Medicine in Saint Kitt's and Nevis in the Caribbean. Though nervous about his first international flight on his way to the island, Lanse soon made St. Kitts home and experienced more adventure and friendship, finding time in his studies to make memories while hiking, boating and getting involved in intramural sports. He began working at the same vet clinic where his journey started - the Kaufman Vet Center. There Dr. Fox practiced medicine, learning Spanish to better communicate with his patient families. Lanse passed away March 8, 2014, in a Dallas hospital. As an organ donor, in death Lanse saved the lives of other people, continuing his legacy of making people's lives around him better.

Requirements

Applications completely filled out.

Essay question: *In what ways have you contributed to your community, work, or charitable organization? Beyond your career aspirations, how do you plan to use your degree to enrich and give back to your community?* (re-read your essay checking for grammatical and spelling errors)
